6893 comes with the AgriSure<sup>™</sup> 3220A trait, a trait that is considered to have the best above ground insect protection because it contains the Viptera<sup>™</sup> trait that protects against black cutworm, corn earworm, fall armyworm and western bean cutworm in addition to european corn borer. We recommend AgriSure 3220 hybrids for delayed planting situations due to their superior protection against corn earworm which has confirmed resistance to several older traits such as VT Double Pro<sup>™</sup>and AcreMax<sup>™</sup>.

6893 carries our highest rating for drought tolerance due to its AgriSure Artesian<sup>®</sup> technology. 6893 also has great ear flex so it is a good hybrid to plant at lower populations on droughty soils.

\*Although we have not yet seen Goss's Wilt in North Central Missouri, we recommend including a proven, high yielding hybrid with high scores on Goss's Wilt into your crop plan to provide maxium protection in case the disease spreads to our area.

## Third Party testing against Competitive Hybrids

In the 2021 University of Missouri Variety test ProHarvest 6893 AS3220 beat Dekalb DKC 61-98 by 3.2 bushels and Pioneer 1151AM, an AquaMax™ hybrid by an average of 12.4 bushels across 5 North Missouri locations.
