This hybrid is great for the variable soil and weather conditions we get in North Missouri because of its solid agronomic scores. We fast tracked some production a year sooner than we normally would because of its yield record against key competitive check hybrids in research data compiled by the genetic provider. 85P34 did excel in Resor Seeds 2022 full season replicated research trial yielding 6.9 bpa above the plot average, not significantly less than the highest yielding entry and ahead of both competitive checks.

85P34 has the AgriSure™3220 trait which contains Viptera™ providing the best above ground insect protection on the market. Couple that with the excellent disease ratings and low green snap risk and 85P34 gives you much less things to worry about during the growing season.

When you scout 85P34 in the fall don't be fooled by the smaller ear girth of 85P34, it has the smallest cob diameter of any hybrid we have ever sold, as seen in the photo above. We have hand shelled samples that were 90% grain where, 82-84% is more typical.
